A Physician, A Veterinarian And An Epidemiologist To Talk About Threat Of Ticks And Disease With Media

CHARLESTON, WEST VIRGINIA – Representatives of the Kanawha-Charleston Health Department will talk with members of the media at Coonskin Park on Wednesday, May 17, at 1 p.m., to share information about the threat of tick season, and to answer questions about ticks including, "Can ticks be a year-round problem?"

KCHD's health officer and regional epidemiologist will be joined by a local veterinarian and her dogs to talk about the threat that ticks present to human and pet health. There also will be a collection of ticks for photographs and video purposes.
